Upon arrival, students may bring with them a curriculum vitae and a graphic portfolio with samples of their work, to show to their ETSAB academic advisor.  Follow the indications on <a href="#">How to prepare your LEARNING AGREEMENT (Before the Mobility)</a> This first version of the LEARNING AGREEMENT will be provisionally signed by ETSAB International Office (or validated online via EWP-Erasmus Without Papers when possible) and IT DOES NOT IMPLY A RESERVATION OF THE CHOSEN COURSES. The availability of subjects and class groups will only be known at the moment of enrolment and changes are very likely to happen. Once the enrolment at ETSAB is fully completed (including changes periods in September & January) ETSAB International Office will sign or validate online via EWP the EXCEPTIONAL CHANGES in the LEARNING AGREEMENT accordingly.  <b>It is mandatory that all exchange and visiting students coming to UPC book a private insurance that covers them for their stay</b> , which includes <b>health assistance</b> (including diagnostic tests and surgical interventions), <b>accidents</b> , (compensation for permanent disability and death compensation), <b>repatriation</b> and <b>civil liability</b> . <b>EU students.</b> Students from the European Union (or Norway or Switzerland) need to have both the <a href="#">European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</a> and an additional private insurance. Upon arrival and before the enrolment at ETSAB, students will be asked to hand in an INSURANCE STATEMENT document duly completed and signed, with a copy of the insurance policy contracted with these coverages.

<p><b>Academic Calendar</b></p> <p><b>Preferred period of stay</b></p> <p>Problems for study in 2<sup>nd</sup> semester</p>	<p>First semester: <b>from early September to end of January</b>  Second semester: <b>from February to end of June</b>  <i>*accurate calendar will be known later on</i></p> <p>Depending on the bilateral agreement, the stay may be for one year or one semester. In the case of agreements for annual stays, semestral stays are also accepted, but only in the first term (September-January). The number of places remains unchanged, regardless of the duration of the stay.</p> <p><b>IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO COME JUST FOR THE SECOND SEMESTER (February -June)</b>  <b>Enrolment of incoming students takes place in September for the full year</b>  <i>ONLY when specified at the bilateral agreement, or very exceptionally at request of the partner university, ETSAB may authorize second semester stays.</i>  <i>Important note: the academic offer will be adjusted to the availability at the time of arrival</i></p>
<p><b>Academic structure</b></p>	<p><a href="http://etsab.upc.edu/en/international/incoming/study-at-etsab">http://etsab.upc.edu/en/international/incoming/study-at-etsab</a></p> <p>ETSAB ARCHITECTURE studies are organized into a 5+1 years structure:</p> <p><b>GRADO EN ESTUDIOS DE ARQUITECTURA</b> (Degree in Architecture Studies)  <b>GA<sub>ArqEtsaB</sub></b> = 300 ECTS in 5 years  +  <b>MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN ARQUITECTURA</b> (Master's Degree in Architecture)  <b>MA<sub>ArqEtsaB</sub></b> = 60 ECTS in 1 year</p> <p>GA<sub>ArqEtsaB</sub> along with MA<sub>ArqEtsaB</sub> is an integrated academic programme that enables the practice as Architect in Spain (regulated profession)</p> <p>POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES</p> <p>ETSAB has restructured its postgraduate academic offer, merging most former Master Degree programmes, which in general are not offered to exchange and visiting students.</p> <p><b>MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN PAISAJISMO</b> (Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture)  <b>MB<sub>LandArch</sub></b> = 120 ECTS in 2 years</p> <p><b>MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN ESTUDIOS AVANZADOS EN ARQUITECTURA-BARCELONA</b>  (Master's degree in Advanced Studies in Architecture-Barcelona)  <b>MB<sub>Arch</sub></b> = 60 ECTS in 1 year, 9 different tracks</p> <p><b>MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN ESTUDIOS AVANZADOS EN DISEÑO-BARCELONA</b>  (Master's degree in Advanced Studies in Design-Barcelona)  <b>MB<sub>Design</sub></b> = 60 ECTS in 1 year, 5 different tracks</p>
<p><b>Academic offer</b>  Courses available for exchange students</p> <p>Advanced knowledge preferred</p> <p>Enrolment</p> <p><b>Enrolment criteria</b> for exchange students (visiting students)</p>	<p>Incoming Exchange students will enrol courses of <b>GRADO EN ESTUDIOS DE ARQUITECTURA</b> GA<sub>ArqEtsaB</sub>.  Academic offer details are updated every year in July (elective courses offer, class schedules...)</p> <p>Besides, MASTER UNIVERSITARIO EN PAISAJISMO MB<sub>LandArch</sub> courses are available only for Erasmus+ and EMiLA Landscape students when specified in the Bilateral Agreement.</p> <p>Other ETSAB's study programmes (MA<sub>ArqEtsaB</sub>, MB<sub>Arch</sub> or MB<sub>Design</sub>) are NOT included in Exchange Bilateral Agreements.  <i>Exceptionally, some MB<sub>Arch</sub> elective courses taught in English may be offered ONLY TO THOSE EXCHANGE STUDENTS WITH MORE THAN 180 ECTS (equal to 6 semesters) already achieved in their previous Architecture studies. (Not applicable to SICUE and Visiting students)</i></p> <p><b>It is strongly recommended that, upon arrival, Architecture exchange students have completed 6 semesters at their home university (180 ECTS credits).</b></p> <p>Annual enrolment in September, both autumn and spring semester subjects must be chosen. Changes only allowed at specific dates of September &amp; January</p> <p>It is recommended not to take more than 5-6 subjects (24-30 ECTS) <b>per semester</b>  <i>(Visiting students at undergraduate degrees (grados) are allowed to enrol a maximum of 60 ECTS credits during their stay at UPC)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Compulsory subjects from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> year:</b> They may enrol any subject of their interest, choosing the semester, according to the availability of class groups.  &gt;&gt; Maximum 1 Architectural Design Studio + 1 Urban Planning Studio per semester</li> <li>• <b>Elective subjects</b> have a limited number of places. While reserving a percentage of them for exchange/visiting we cannot guarantee its availability for all students. Their schedule may overlap with compulsory courses  &gt;&gt; Maximum 2-3 elective courses per semester, according to availability</li> <li>• <b>Final Thesis Project (TFG) is not open</b> to incoming exchange/visiting students</li> </ul>

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<p><b>Medium of instruction</b></p> <p>Language for exchange students</p> <p>Language requirements</p>	<p>SPANISH and CATALAN are the languages of instruction at ETSAB Architecture Degree classes, although some elective subjects and specific class groups in Arch. Design &amp; Urban Design Studios and other core subjects are offered in ENGLISH, with limited places available.</p> <p><b>ETSAB strongly recommend having at least a B1 level of Spanish before arrival.</b> Incoming students are not required to submit a proof of Spanish or Catalan language skills, however partner universities should take that into consideration for nomination.</p>
