The objective of the Explaining Cerdanyola's identity following the river workshop is complementary to the technical and functional information to incorporate into the project an approach towards art as an important component for the construction of a total landscape architecture that sensitizes society

To help this creative process the student is introduced to the territorial dialectics which through the interdisciplinary diagram and the identity project as a work proposal guides the student in the incorporation of identity and more sustained manifestations in art.

The total landscape concept means that the landscape of our environments is constantly being perceived, the whole of the physical space of the classroom and the set of students and teachers is a changing landscape in which we are landscape and observer of this at the same time, in a constant mirror game.
