The project spans two climatic zones, north and south, and takes the two historical and cultural cities of Harbin and Shanghai as its research samples. Through Walking and Mapping, the project explores the historical layers and future posibilities in urban space:

- Historical imprints: morphogenetic in a trans-geographical context
- Contemporary imprints: heritage conservation practices in twin cities
- Future imprints: urban possibilities in the age of innovation
