ADMISSION OF EXCHANGE STUDENTS Exchange students must be nominated by their home institution, according to the conditions and number of places of the bilateral agreement. More info > Exchange Students

ADMISSION OF VISITING STUDENTS

ETSAB offers 20 vacancies for those students who want to spend a semester or a full academic year studying Architecture at ETSAB, but belong to foreign universities without any specific exchange agreement with our school. More info at > Visting Students

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS: ETSAB strongly recommend having at least a B1 level of Spanish before arrival. Incoming students are not required to submit a proof of Spanish or Catalan language skills, however partner universities should take that into consideration for nomination.



UPC International Students Office (OMI) is the reception office for international students coming to any UPC campus. It is compulsory to contact them within the **first 10 days** of your arrival in Spain.

ETSAB STUDY PROGRAMMES OFFERED TO INCOMING MOBILITY STUDENTS

Incoming exchange and visiting students will enrol only courses of ETSAB's Degree in Architecture Studies GArqEtsab GRADO EN ESTUDIOS DE ARQUITECTURA plan 2014

Composed by 300 ECTS = 270 ECTS compulsory subjects + 24 ECTS elective subjects + 6 ECTS TFG 5 years / 60 ECTS credits per academic year 1 ECTS = 25-30 hours (50% contact hours at class / 50% self-study hours)

Spanish and Catalan are the languages of instruction at ETSAB. A limited number of courses are given in English: some elective subjects and specific groups of some Design Studios and most Compulsory Courses of the 3rd year.

Besides, **MBLandArch** courses are available for some Erasmus+ and EMiLA exchange students, only when specified in the Bilateral Agreement (please check ETSAB exchange partners list). Note: the new Bachelor's Degree in Landscape Architecture courses are NOT available for these students.

Any other ETSAB's Master or PhD programmes are NOT included in Exchange Bilateral Agreements. Neither MArqEtsaB nor MBArch & MBDesign courses are available for exchange/visiting students.

ENROLMENT CRITERIA FOR INCOMING MOBILITY STUDENTS:

You may enrol GRADO EN ESTUDIOS DE ARQUITECTURA course units, according to these conditions:

• **COMPULSORY subjects from 1**st to 5th year: You may enrol at any subject of your interest. You will have to choose the semester (many subjects are offered in both semesters), although the availability of places in a particular group (different class schedules) will only be known at the moment of enrolment

j! STUDIO COURSES > Maximum per semester:

- 1 Architectural Design Studio (Bases para el Proyecto/Proyectos/Taller Temático)
- +1 Urban Planning Studio (Urbanística)
- ELECTIVE subjects: Many of them have limited number of places (for both mobility and regular students). While reserving a percentage of places for exchange/visiting, we cannot guarantee its availability for all students. Please consider several options in your choice, because only at the moment of your enrolment you will know if there are still places available or not.
 - j! Elective courses schedule may overlap with compulsory courses
- Final Thesis Project (TFG) is not open to incoming Exchange/Visiting students
- Number of credits:
 - EXCHANGE/VISITING student: It is recommended to take no more than 5-6 subjects (24-30 ECTS) per semester VISITING student: According to UPC regulations, you are allowed to enroll a maximum of 60 ECTS credits

WARNING: Learning Agreements will be validated(EWP)/signed by ETSAB International Office, preferably after enrolment in September, because the availability of many courses will only be known at the moment of registration and changes are very likely to happen. Any Learning Agreement submitted before can only be validated/signed provisionally and it doesn't imply a reservation of the courses chosen.
